

# Zoology/Biology II Article Review

## Project First Nine Weeks

### Due Monday October 13, 2008

Students will choose an article from a newspaper, magazine, or journal pertaining to something in the science field. Refer to website [www.frogstudy.com](http://www.frogstudy.com) for links to assist.

Your review must be types using the following format:

1. Heading- Name and date
2. Twelve-point font, one-inch margins (top, bottom and sides.), use Times New Roman Font
3. List the name of the article
4. List the name of the publication, date, volume, and number (if available). If using a website list the url.
5. Attach a copy of the article.
6. Write 10 facts or ideas you learned from this article.
  - a. Use complete sentences.
  - b. Skip a line between facts
  - c. Number each fact
  - d. Be sure facts come from the entire article (not just the first few paragraphs.)
  - e. Avoid pronouns (it, they) when stating a fact.
    - i. **Example of what not to do:** They were destroyed by it.
    - ii. **Example of what to do:** The fish and bird life of Santa Monica were destroyed by the California oil spill of 1993.
    - iii. Note: Each fact should stand-alone and make perfect sense.
7. Write at least one paragraph summarizing your opinion of the information included in the article. What specifically did you like? What did you not like about the article? What did you learn? Was there any bias in the article?
