Students will watch a Video Podcast from Science Friday. This can be done either using the App on the iPad or going to www.sciencefriday.com and click on videos.

No student in the same class period can watch the same video so as soon as you choose a video you like you must post the name and the date on the class blog. Go to <http://frogstudy.edublogs.org/> Choose the post that is for your class period and comment. Your comment must include your first name, video podcast title, and video podcast date. Please read others responses first because someone might have already chosen your topic and each can only be chosen once each class period.

You will type your review in NoteMaster.

Title the Note with Your first and last name and class period.

Your review must be types using the following format:

1. Header- Name, date, title of Video Podcast the Video Podcast. (You will need to add 4 separate headers for each to be its own line.)
2. Write 10 facts or ideas you learned from this article.
 - a. Use complete sentences.
 - b. Number the facts using the number feature.
 - c. Be sure facts come from the entire podcast (not just the first few seconds.)
 - d. Avoid pronouns (it, they) when stating a fact.
 - i. **Example of what not to do:** They were destroyed by it.
 - ii. **Example of what to do:** The fish and bird life of Santa Monica were destroyed by the California oil spill of 1993.
 - iii. Note: Each fact should stand-alone and make perfect sense.
3. Write at least one paragraph summarizing your opinion of the information included in the article. What specifically did you like? What did you not like about the article? What did you learn? Was there any bias in the article?
4. When you are done or at the end of the period sync the note with your Google Docs.
 - a. To do this go to the  icon. There is where you put your log-in information.
 - b. Then go to the  to sync. You now need to check your Docs.
 - c. Go to the Google App to check for the file. 
5. In the Google App share the file with Rachel.gensburg@tctchome.com You can do this by going to Google Docs in the App, selecting the file, and sharing it with me. This is the ONLY way the assignments will be accepted. No print copies, e-mail copies etc will be accepted. All work must be turned in by 11:59pm Friday January 6, 2012 (EST).
